PILGRIMAGE TO THE HOLY LAND & JORDAN

March 6 - 19, 2019



Day 1 - March 6: Depart USA

Our pilgrimage begins today as we depart on our flight to Israel. Meals and drinks served aloft.

Day 2 - March 7: Arrive Tel Aviv

Upon arrival at Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv we will be met by our local guide who will escort us throughout our stay in the Holy Land and make the scripture come alive as we follow in the footsteps of Jesus. Drive to our hotel in Tel Aviv for overnight.

Day 3 - March 8: Tel Aviv / Tiberias

This morning we will depart Tel Aviv and drive north along the Mediterranean coast to Caesarea, the capital of the ancient Roman Procurators of Judea where St. Peter preached and St. Paul was imprisoned for two years. Visit the Roman Theater, Crusader's Moat, and the Byzantine Churches. Continue to the sparkling port city of Haifa. Ascend Mt. Carmel, home of the prophets Elijah and Elisha, to celebrate Mass at Stella Maris. Continue on to Tiberias for check-in at our hotel located on the shores of the Sea of Galilee.



Day 4 - March 9: Tiberias


This morning we will visit the Nof Ginosaur Kibbutz to see the ancient wooden "Jesus Boat" that was discovered on the shores of the Sea of Galilee in 1986. Enjoy a scenic boat ride across the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum, home of Our Lord during his ministry. After visiting the synagogue where He taught, proceed to Tabgha, site of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes, and to the nearby Church of the Primacy of Peter. Then drive up to the Mt. of the Beatitudes for Mass at the site of the Sermon on the Mount. The remainder of the afternoon will be free.

Day 5 - March 10: Tiberias

Following breakfast, drive to Cana of Galilee, where Our Lord performed the first miracle - changing water into wine at the wedding feast. Here, we'll invite couples to renew their marriage vows celebrate Sunday Mass with the local Christian community. Then proceed to Nazareth where we will visit the Basilica of the Annunciation, Joseph's Workshop, the Cave of the Annunciation, the Church of St. Joseph, the Church of the Holy Family, the House of Mary & Joseph, and Mary's Well. In the afternoon take an excursion to the summit of Mt. Tabor to visit the site of the Transfiguration of Jesus.

Day 6 - March 11: Tiberias / Petra

This morning we will depart Tiberias and drive to the Sheikh Hussein Bridge where we will cross from Israel into Jordan. Then drive south to Mount Nebo where Moses first viewed the promised land. After Mass on Mt. Nebo, we will proceed to Madaba, a Byzantine center of master mosaics, to see the oldest surviving map of the Holy Land. Continue on to Petra, one of the most magnificent sites in the Middle East, and check-in at our hotel.



Day 7 - March 12: Petra

Today will be spent exploring the "Red Rose City" of Petra which is literally carved into the sides of a deep gorge. Riding on horseback (the horseback ride is optional and no riding experience is required) between the 100 foot cliffs we will see a remarkable sight: temples, tombs, and dwellings chiseled right into the limestone walls. We'll be awed as we view the masterpieces of the Treasury made famous by the movie "Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade", the Monastery, the Triumphal Arch and the Roman Amphitheater.

Day 8 - March 13: Petra / Jerusalem

This morning we will check out of our hotel and drive north to visit the traditional baptismal site on the Jordan River, which is known as Bethany Beyond the Jordan, where we will have an opportunity to renew our baptismal vows. We will then continue to the Allenby Bridge where we will cross from Jordan back into Israel. We will then proceed to Jerusalem for check-in at our hotel.

Day 9 - March 14: Jerusalem

This morning, drive to Bethlehem. Above the traditional Grotto of Jesus' birth, visit the Nativity Church, built by Constantine in the 4th Century. Then tour the Manger, the Grotto of St. Jerome where we will celebrate Mass, the Church of St. Catherine, and the Shepherd's Fields. During our visit here, we will have ample time for shopping at Manger Square and for visits to some of the projects supported by the North Central Lieutenancy including the Caritas Baby Hospital, and Bethlehem University where we will have lunch. In the afternoon we will visit the Israel Museum to see a scale model of Jerusalem as it appeared 2,000 years ago and the Shrine of the Book which is an exhibit focused on the Dead Sea Scrolls.



Day 10 - March 15: Jerusalem

This morning we will begin the day with a visit to the top of the Mount of Olives for a spectacular view of Jerusalem. Visit the Church of Pater Noster where Jesus taught the Lord's prayer to his Disciples and the Chapel of Ascension where Jesus ascended into Heaven forty days after his resurrection. Then walk along the "Palm Sunday Road" to Dominus Flevit where Our Lord wept over Jerusalem. Continue to the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations where we will celebrate Mass.

Day 11 - March 16: Jerusalem

Early this morning we will celebrate Mass at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre before returning to our hotel for breakfast. Then later in the morning we will return to the Old City of Jerusalem and visit the Church of St. Anne, the Pool of Bethesda, the Chapel of Flagellation, Lithostrotos, and the Arch of the "Ecce Homo". Then follow the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre to visit Golgotha and the Tomb of Our Lord. We will then visit the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem in order to receive our Pilgrim Shells. We will conclude the day visiting with Fr. David Neuhaus and the local Hebrew-Catholic community.



Day 12 - March 17: Jerusalem

This morning we will drive to Abu Ghosh where we will celebrate Sunday Mass at St. Mary of the Resurrection Abbey. Return to Jerusalem and view the Temple Area of the Old City featuring the beautiful Dome of the Rock, Mosque el Aqsa, and the Wailing Wall. Continue to Mt. Zion to visit the Cenacle or Upper room. Then survey King David's Tomb, the Dormition Abbey, and St. Peter in Gallicantu where Peter denied Jesus three times. In the afternoon we will drive to Ein Karem, birthplace of St. John the Baptist, to see the Visitation Church where Mary proclaimed her famous "Magnificat" and the Church of St. John the Baptist which marks the birthplace of John the Baptist.

Day 13 - March 18: Jerusalem

This morning drive to Bethany to visit and celebrate Mass at the site of the House of Mary, Martha and Lazarus, where we'll visit the Tomb of Lazarus. Drive through the Judean Wilderness and along the Dead Sea to Qumran to see the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered and then on to ancient Jericho, the oldest known city in the Western World. See the sycamore tree of Zacchaeus and then proceed to the top of the archeological "tel," where we'll have an excellent view of Elisha's Fountain, the Qarantal, and the Mt. of Temptation. Return to Jerusalem. This evening enjoy a Middle Eastern dinner party at a local restaurant.



Day 14 - March 19: Jerusalem / Tel Aviv / USA

Today marks the end of our Holy Land pilgrimage as we transfer to the airport to catch our return flight home.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS

Reservations and Payment: Please complete the attached Reservation Application and return it with your deposit of \$300.00 per person at the time of booking. Final payment is due 65 days prior to departure.

Cancellations: All cancellations must be in writing. The following per person cancellation charges will apply: If canceled 91 days or more prior to departure, a \$50.00 administrative fee will be charged. If canceled 90 - 61 days prior to departure, \$250.00 will be charged. If canceled 60 - 31 days prior to departure, \$450.00 will be charged. If canceled 30 - 7 days prior to departure \$700.00 will be charged. No refunds will be made within 6 days of departure. In addition, once the airline tickets have been issued, 100% of the airfare is non-refundable unless you have been advised otherwise at the time of your booking. Additional cancellation charges may apply depending upon the cancellation terms of our suppliers.

Refunds: Subject to the foregoing Cancellation Terms, upon cancellation of travel related services, all sums paid to George's International Tours for such services will be promptly returned to the passenger, <u>provided</u> the passenger has not caused such cancellation and is not in violation of any of the terms and conditions previously, clearly and conspicuously disclosed and agreed to by the passenger. This refund provision does not apply where George's International Tours has remitted the payment to another registered seller of travel or a carrier and they default in providing the agreed-upon transportation or service without providing a refund. In such a situation, George's International Tours agrees to provide passenger with a written statement accompanied by a copy of the bank records establishing the disbursement of the payment, and if disbursed to a seller of travel, proof of their current registration.

Trust Account Disclosure: California law requires certain sellers of travel to have a trust account or bond. George's International Tours has such a trust account.

Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"): George's International Tours is a participant in the Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"). You, the passenger, may request reimbursement from TCRC if the Seller of Travel was registered and participating in the TCRC at the time of sale and the passenger is located in California at the time of payment. Please be advised that passengers purchasing from outside of California are not covered by the TCRC. Eligible passengers may file a claim with TCRC if the passenger is owed a refund of more than \$50 for transportation or travel services which the Seller of Travel failed to forward to a proper provider or if such money was not refunded to you when required. The maximum amount which may be paid by the TCRC to any one passenger is the total amount paid on behalf of the passenger to the Seller of Travel, not to exceed \$15,000. A claim must be submitted to the TCRC within six months after the scheduled completion date of the travel. A claim must include sufficient information and documentation to prove your claim and a \$35 processing fee. You must agree to waive your right to other civil remedies against a registered participating Seller of Travel for matters arising out of a sale for which you file a claim with the TCRC, if you were located in California at the time of the sale. Travel Documents: A passport with a minimum of 6 months validity remaining is required of all U.S. citizens. U.S. citizens do not require visas for entry to Israel but visas are required for entry to Jordan. The cost of the Jordanian visa is included in the cost of your trip and George's International will be procuring a group visa on your behalf. If you are not a U.S. citizen, please call to find out if you need a visa. George's International is not responsible for individual visas or passports.

Tour Cost: All quoted prices are based upon airfares, tariffs and currency exchange rates at the time of printing and are subject to change at any time. Should the minimum number of 20 tour members not be reached, the right is reserved to increase the tour cost accordingly.

Baggage: Each passenger is allowed one checked bag and one carry-on. You will be responsible for paying to the airline any additional charges for additional checked baggage or overweight baggage (if excess weight is permitted). George's International Tours is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen baggage.

Air Transportation: Air travel is in economy class on Lufthansa (or any other IATA carrier). Fares are based upon levels in effect at the time of printing. Fares and flight schedules are subject to change without notice.
