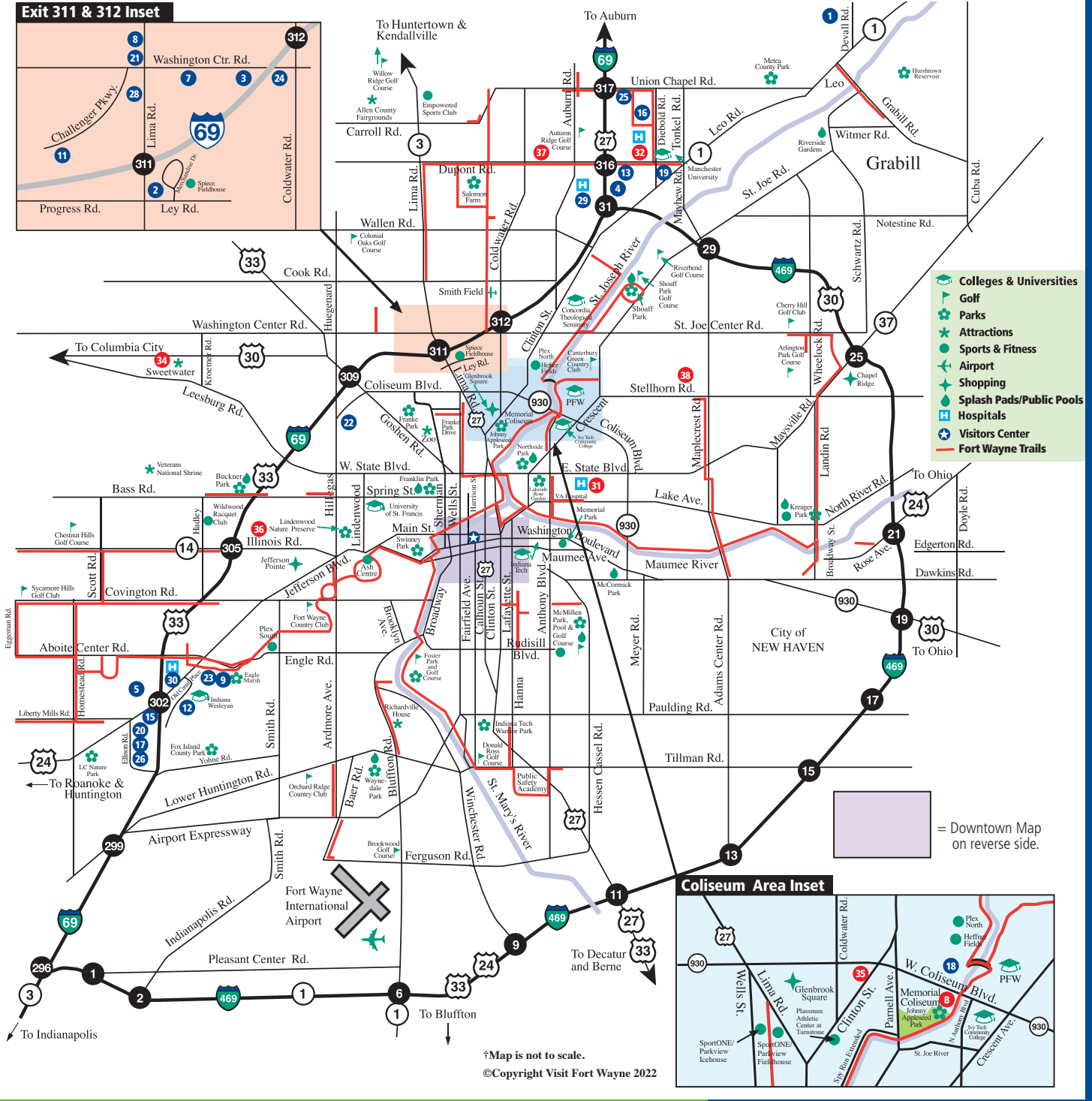
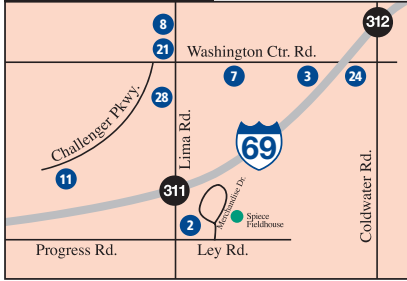
DOWNTOWN MAP
