

Guest Speakers



Rev. Aquinas Guilbeau, O.P., S.T.D.

University Chaplain and Vice President of Ministry and Mission at Catholic University of America.

A native of Louisiana, Father Aquinas entered the Dominican Province of St. Joseph in 2005. After several years of pastoral work in New York City, he began doctoral studies in theology at the University of Fribourg (Switzerland), where he completed a dissertation on St. Thomas Aquinas's doctrine of the common good. Before arriving at Catholic University, Father Aquinas taught moral theology at the nearby Dominican House of Studies, where he also served for a time as prior of the community.

In October of 2023, Father Aquinas was appointed by President Peter K. Kilpatrick as the University's first Vice President of Ministry and Mission, a position that places him in the president's cabinet alongside other University vice presidents, where he will assist the President in animating the Catholic character of the University.

Fr. Aquinas is a much sought after speaker and was one of the main hosts for EWTN's television coverage of the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis last summer.



Sami El-Yousef

Sami El-Yousef is the Chief Executive Officer of the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem where he assumed this responsibility in September 2017, being the first lay administrator to ever serve in this role since the re-establishment of the LPJ in 1847.

Prior to his appointment as CEO in 2017, he served as the Regional Director of the Jerusalem field office of the CNEWA - Pontifical Mission for Palestine and enjoyed a 24-year career in academia, including teaching and administrative positions at Bethlehem University, the last of which was to serve as the first lay Vice President for Finances and Planning.

Over the decades, Sami has made hundreds of field visits to various institutions of the local churches across the Holy Land. As CEO, he deals with the complexity of operations in the three very different countries of Palestine, Jordan, and Israel without losing sight of the mission and vision of the Church and its services in education, humanitarian aid, and pastoral care.

A native of the Old City of Jerusalem and belongs to one of the thirteen oldest Christian families with continuous presence in Jerusalem for centuries. He pursued his higher education in the United States receiving degrees from the University of Massachusetts in Amherst, and the University of Pittsburgh.



Guest Speakers



Professor Ronald J. Rychlak, J.D.

Distinguished University Professor and Jamie L. Whitten Chair in Law and Government at the University of Mississippi.

A member of the University of Mississippi law school faculty since 1987, Ron Rychlak in 2019 received the university's highest research and publication recognition, the "Distinguished Research and Creative Achievement Award" based upon his reputation for scholarly activity and leadership roles in professional societies. In 2023, he received the Algernon Sydney Sullivan Award, the University's highest award in honor of service, for "placing service to other s and the community before oneself, while embodying the qualities of honesty, morality, ethics, integrity, responsibility, determination, courage, and compassion."

Ron is a graduate of Wabash College (BA 1980, cum laude) and Vanderbilt University School of Law (JD 1983, Order of the Coif). Prior to joining the faculty, he practiced law with Jenner & Block in Chicago and served as a clerk to Judge Harry Wellford of the U.S. Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals.

Ron is the author, co-author, or editor of twelve books and over 100 articles. The Congregation for the Causes of Saints at the Vatican called his book, *Hitler, the War, and the Pope* "definitive" in its response to charges made against the leader of the Catholic Church during World War II. He has been published in Notre Dame Law Review, UCLA Law Review, The Washington Post, The Wall Street Journal, and numerous other periodicals and journals. Media appearances include CNN, ABC, Fox News, National Geographic TV; The Military Channel; PBS radio; Coast to Coast with George Noory; C - SPAN; and more.
